Dr Tang Tjun Yip is from The Vascular and Endovascular Clinic, a vascular and general surgeon at Gleneagles Hospital, Singapore. An accomplished Vascular and General Surgeon, have performed more than 500 vascular operations every year for the past 12 years.

Dr Tang is a former senior consultant in the department of vascular surgery at Singapore General Hospital, and a consultant in the vascular service in the department of general surgery at Changi General Hospital. He also helped to establish the vascular service at Sengkang General Hospital.

Also an accomplished researcher, Dr Tang has written or co-authored 300+ peer-reviewed publications and has 10 book chapters and 5 books to his name. He was appointed Research Director of the SingHealth Duke-NUS Vascular Centre.

Dr Tang is the recipient of several awards including the National Medical Research Council Clinician Scientist Award, SingHealth Healthcare Hero and Service with a Heart Award.
